## Sportsman's Bar Moving to Temporary Outlets

Dear Member,

We have now reached the much-anticipated next stage of the Sportsman's Kitchen rebuild and Bar refreshment project where work will begin on the Sportsman's Bar itself and we will move to temporary outlets and service areas, primarily to the Front Deck and the Family Lounge.

### Timeframe

Sunday 15th May	Sportsman's Bar closes for the final time at 10pm and the area will be closed off for construction work
Tuesday 17th May	Temporary outlets and service areas open

---

### Temporary outlets

**Sportsman's Bar Front Deck** - between the outdoor green and main pitch.

Air cooled marquees serving the same A la Carte menu and daily specials as before, as well as soft drinks, wines, spirits, bottle beers, plus 6 draught beers. Government regulations allows seating for 76 places.

Opening hours:	Monday to Friday:	2pm - 10pm
	Saturday and Sunday:	9am - 10pm
	Public Holidays:	11am - 10pm

**Family Lounge** – on the 1/FI next to the ten pin bowling alley.

Opening hours will be extended with a full bar and table service and a comprehensive range of soft drinks, wines, beers, and spirits. TVs and a drop-down projector screen for screening live sports.

Opening hours: 10:00am - 10:00 pm

---

All other Food and Beverage outlets will be available as usual and when necessary, the **Happy Valley Suites** or **Sports Hall** will be set up for major sports broadcasting.

---

We expect the construction work to last until December 2022 and we will be providing you with regular updates on progress throughout.
