## All F&B Outlets and Banquet Events move into Mode D of Operation

Dear Member,

The Club is striving to make life go back to normal or, indeed the new “normal”. As such, some of you may have recognised the Sportsman’s Bar and the Restaurant moved to Mode D of Operation last week on trial runs. I am happy to say that all went well on the trial runs and that from next Monday 2nd August all Food and Beverage Outlets and Banquet Events will move into Mode D of Operation as well.

Under Mode D of Operation we can:

Dine-in service hours	If required have the Outlets stay open until 2am (Meaning all Outlets will go back to their normal pre-pandemic operating hours)
Occupancy of the Outlets	100%
Maximum number of persons per table	12 persons
Maximum number of persons per Banquet event	Up to 180 persons per event

To enjoy the Mode D of Operation besides using the Leave Home Safe app upon arrival to the Club two-thirds of the attendees in your group must have had at least 1 dose of the COVID vaccination. Members and guests will need to show their vaccination record to Staff upon seating in the Outlet you are dining/drinking in and we thank you in advance for your co-operation in this matter and in particular by ensuring your guests are fully aware that they are likely to be required to show proof of vaccination when they are sat at table.

If you are not able to follow the specific measures required by Government, don’t worry, as each Outlet will keep a small section open which will continue operating under Mode C of Operation.

If you have any queries as regards Mode D of Operation then please contact the Outlet that you are looking to dine in/drink at directly.
